



HIGH SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

Please take these supplies to your student's homeroom teacher to be left in the classroom. These will be used for instruction for your child and for sanitizing the environment. Why do they have to bring supplies if they should have them with them, too? They run out, they leave them at home, they forget to bring them, etc. This ensures that they are always prepared. It is very helpful to have supplies from every student, and we thank you for your help in advance!!

- 4 reams of white copy paper
- 5 packs of college ruled notebook paper (They go through this VERY quickly!)
- 1000 index cards (for vocabulary)
- 24 pencils
- pack of blue or black pens
- 4 Expo dry-erase markers
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 roll of paper towels

Students should have the following items in their backpacks so that they may use them in class or at home.

- 6 binders with subject dividers for each class
- 2 composition books for science
- 1 spiral notebook for Spanish
- Highlighters
- Graph paper for math
- Correction tape
- Agenda
- Flash drive
- Ruler
- Compass with metal point, ruler, and plastic protractor for Geometry
- Calculator for math and science classes: For Algebra II and higher: graphing calculator (Texas Instruments TI-84 plus is recommended ~ \$120) For Algebra I and Geometry- scientific calculator (Texas Instruments T130X is recommended ~ \$12).
